EIASE serves children in eight counties including Clark, Coles, Cumberland, Douglas, Edgar, Effingham, Moultrie, and Shelby. The co-op offers itinerant programming to all twenty-eight school districts within these counties. EIASE also hosts four self-contained sites including Carl Sandburg Elementary (pre-kindergarten through 3rd grade), Jefferson School (grades 4 through 6), Charleston Middle School (grades 7-8), and Charleston High School (grades 9-12).

As of the 2015-2016 School Year the self-contained sites will be moved to the Mattoon School District at Williams Elementary School (K-5), Mattoon Middle School (6-8) and Mattoon High School (9-12).
