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Description

The Illinois School for the Deaf (ISD) is a state supported school for the education of children who are deaf or hard of hearing. The educational program is recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education and is accredited by the North Central Association. Comprehensive programming includes 0-3, preschool, elementary, junior high, and high school levels. A college preparatory curriculum and an extensive career and technical education program are emphasized in the upper grades. Residential facilities are available for students living 25 or more miles from ISD. Children living in Jacksonville and the surrounding area may attend as day students. Illinois School for the Deaf is an accessible bilingual communication community in which people who are Deaf, Hard of Hearing, and hearing learn and work together without communication barriers. Extracurricular activities including scouting and a full athletic and recreation program are available to children. The school is a member of the Illinois High School Association and the Illinois Elementary School Association.

Description

This Birth to Three program serves families using the mode of communication that they choose and services are provided under the guidelines presented in the Illinois Early Intervention system. Staff members are qualified to use auditory/oral methods and/or sign language and have experience working with children who use cochlear implants, BAHA*s, or hearing aids. Services include evaluation/assessment, individual and/or group sessions, parent to parent networking, transition planning and access to a wide variety of resources and information. Services can be provided in the family's home or the family's community.
